3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To provide, guide, educate and to create health awareness program and to make, develop, build, promote Health Care Centre for the underprivileged public.
2. To develop, Establish, promote, facilitate, promotion, improvement of educational, social, cultural and medical relief to the poor and downtrodden and advancement of any other charitable and developmental objects of general public utility and community welfare.
3. To promote commerce, art, science, sports, education, research, social welfare, religion, charity, protection of environment or any such other object.
4. To help alleviate poverty by enabling access to the basic necessities of life including clean, safe and nutritious food; clean and safe drinking water; shelter; education; and livelihoods for people deprived from such access.
5. To promote social welfare activities intended for the general welfare of the public such as welfare of the destitute,

family, women, children and the handicapped, old age, sickness, disablement and other cases of deserving needs

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

6. To provide primary health care to slum dwellers at a nominal cost, if and when required, and to make it accessible to all by providing the same at their doorsteps with particular attention to the child health care, adolescent girls, women and to create health awareness among the underprivileged children, girls and women.

7. To provide, assist and to create helpline/helpdesk for secondary and other complicated cases of health problems, networking with various related agencies in the local area and supporting it with whatever is necessary for providing medical aid and guidance.

8. To create awareness about a clean environment, Planned Parenthood, and immunizations of all children against most dreaded communicable diseases and to impart knowledge about health, food, proper diet, clean drinking water and improvisation.

9. Early intervention to children with special needs in integrated manner with proper education and guidance to the public enabling them to be competent to take care of themselves.

10. To carry out AIDS, corona, and other health awareness programs in the community targeting the adolescent boys and girls in urban and rural areas with special camps and education centres for the subject.

11. To provide opportunities to develop skills

and talents of children and women with the aim of generating a sustainable income and be independent to march with the time and age.

12. To provide, encourage, initiate or promote facilities for the discovery, improvement or development of new methods of diagnosis, understanding and prevention and treatment of diseases at economical cost.

13. To provide, develop and promote research facilities for carrying on research, basic and applied, in all system and discipline of medical and surgical knowledge, keeping in view the socio-medical need of the afflicted community.

14. To identify the gifted children and to provide them all sort of medical aid, health check up and to help through educational scholarships to further their education and good health to become socially aware citizens enabling them to lead a healthy life by understanding the importance of hygiene and regular medical check ups.

15. To promote and establish Health care Centre, infertility center and Educational institutions committed to launching and practicing innovative treatment style and learning methods in the fields that have a bearing on accelerating development in the field of Medical and education. In sharp focus in enriching knowledge, skills and attitude of individuals, particularly through nurturing of individual giftedness amongst children and youths thereby creating in them quality of good citizenship and enabling leadership and who in turn could impact social and other societal changes.

16. To create institutions / centers for identifying

psychological and behavioral characteristics of individuals? and organizations? through use of modern psychology and provide medical aid through suitable and regular health checkup and counseling processes in a conducive environment for enabling comprehensive personality development thereby making individuals / organizations confident of playing leading roles in any social or socioeconomic setting.

17. To provide relief to the poor, medical relief, education, to promote yoga, preservation of environment (including watersheds, forests and wildlife) and preservation of monuments or places or objects of artistic or historic interest, and the advancement of any other object of general public utility

18. To raise awareness on environmental issues and push for changes in policy and development strategies and For environmental monitoring; promoting environmental education, conducts seminars and workshops, training and capacity-building; implementing demonstration projects; conducting advocacy work in partnership with the government; and the promotion of regional and international cooperation on the environment.

19. To work concurrently on environment and development, for acknowledging the fact that environmental problems are embedded in economic and social systems and to promote a healthy relationship among individuals who are actively engaged in environmental related issues through useful interaction, organizing regular meetings and social activities.

20. To set up educational

institutions and other institutions which are offering various courses in environmental and yoga related subjects and get affiliation/approval from university/universities or other institutions for conducting such courses and facilitating Researchers, Students from Foreign Universities.

21. To institute awards, prizes and gifts for encouraging protection of the environment and to establish a printing and publishing house or otherwise bring out periodicals, magazines and books, e-resources and study of data, statistics, laws, news and views on life issues in respect of the environment, natural resources and natural phenomena.

22. To establish a multimedia centre which broadcast environmental protection and sustainable development related materials on both online and mainstream media and to consolidate Environmental journalists, experts, environmentalists, on one platform to bring their broad assessments on key environmental issues to create maximum public awareness to achieve maximum active community participation in environmental protection.

23. Acquire information on nature-friendly technologies and take initiatives to popularize them and to create awareness among the public about the need to reduce wastage of water, fuel and other natural resources and usage of various renewable resources such as solar energy, Wind energy, Biogas etc.

24. Research and find permanent sustainable waste management solutions to reduce the health hazard and sanitation problems caused by

bio-degradable wastes and non-degradable dry wastes. Plan and implement a concerted public awareness campaign on households regarding scientific and effective segregating method of wet and dry garbage.

25. To promote and support ?Swacch Bharat Abhiyan? programmes and to conduct seminars, studies, research on urban pollution, water pollution and flood management and Enlighten the public about the rights, responsibilities and laws for maintaining a sustainable environment by arranging exhibitions, awareness campaigns etc.

26. Work in close liaison with other Associations having similar objectives and with local bodies State Governments, Central Government and The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) for the sustainable environment and also become the part of Environmental impact Assessment programs.

27. To conduct International level Environmental campaigns, whilst giving priority to developing linkages with local NGOs, research institutes, universities and government departments.

28. To purchase, construct, taken on lease or otherwise acquire land, building and other movable and immovable properties and to sell, lease, mortgage or hypothecate or otherwise dispose of all or any of the property and assets of the trust on such terms and conditions as the trust may deem fit for attaining the objects.

29. To accept donations in cash or in kind, grants and collect subscriptions, fees and

other charges for the services rendered by the trust.

30. To do all other lawful acts, as are necessary for and/or incidental to the attainment of the aims and objects of the trust and to promote community or individual action and campaign for greater accountability on the part of the government and corporate sector.

31. To strengthen Internet and World Wide Web capacities for taking full advantage of the growing information technology which provides tantamount opportunities not only for networking both nationwide and worldwide but also for strengthening the capacities of major groups, especially NGOs related to Environmental and Social aspects Facebook Twitter WhatsApp

32. To generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas of the country through setting up of new self-employment ventures/projects and to bring together widely dispersed traditional artisans/ rural and urban unemployed youth and give them self-employment opportunities to the extent possible, at their place.

33. To provide comprehensive and quality care and to ensure that the resident senior citizens live with respect and dignity in secure, compassionate, congenial environment and surroundings and to act as a centre where the knowledge and experiences of life of the senior citizens are utilized in a constructive manner so as to contribute more meaningfully to both, the residents and the society.

34. To establish a social institution where society not only interacts and looks after senior citizens but also learns

from them ?the much-needed values of a healthy and peaceful society and to provide companionship, emotional support, therapeutic occupation, recreation facilities and activities to overcome social isolation and to provide independence to senior citizens in daily life, and to re-establish high values of life nurtured by them.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

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9 True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
